1. Welcome and review Minutes from 9/26/23
 - a. Sean McHenry motioned to approve

2. Review Safe Routes Plan
 - a. Principal Eardley displayed the map with safe routes, and a stoplight on the map was in the wrong spot.
 - b. Stop sign placement is discussed on roads surrounding the school. Principal Eardley will look into signage with the city.
 - c. Issues: More green lines may be added to the map, specifically on 11400 S, to show safe walking routes.

3. Look at possible dates for White Ribbon Week as well as content

4. Update SCC Rules of Order to match changes with State
 - a. Principal Eardley displayed Rules of Order and Procedures from the State and the current SJE-posted rules for comparison.

 - a. The current plan was reviewed. 78% of students showed typical or more growth last year as measured by Acadience. There was a discussion/ideas on creating future goals.
