5. Review Trust Lands Plan 2022-2023

- Goals 70% of students will show typical or above growth as measured by Acadience
- Reading 2 literacy coaches last year, this year only 1. Have increased number of literacy aides to help the one coach this year. We have 8 literacy aides now. Teachers need to do the progress monitoring. TSSA money to help supplement. Walk to read was brand new last year and now teachers now the program better this year. One coach salary can only hire one coach but can hire more aides.
- Math 2021-2021 Rise data we want 48% proficiency. Money for coach and aides and some training professional development. What training can we bring in? What training to teachers want and need?

6. Future meeting dates

- Last year we only met 4 times. Kyle Anderson suggest that we meet monthly with the exception of December. Mark Mabey seconds.

- 7. Rise and Acadience Data 2021-22 and 2022-2023 School Year Data
 - Took 5 weeks to get testing done at the beginning of the year. 5 weeks of teaching before testing.
 - Great scores for BOY, it will be a challenge for growth, instruction will need to adjust to
 meet the students where they are. RISE end of year will be a harder test, how do we get
 our daily teaching to get them thinking more like RISE testing. PLC time is getting better.
 More teaming efforts to get extensions for high level students. PLC is now a planning
 meeting for learning.
- 8. Motion by Mrs. Witt-Roper to talk about Halloween parade and seconded by Emily Bagley.
 - Scheduling for parade in the morning. Specials schedule. 90 minute block for literacy and for math. Increased instructional minutes. Mondays 6th and 4th grades will lose out on rotations.
 - Possibility to move parade to the Thursday before fall break or ask the 6th grade to move rotations to a Friday. This will be a principal decision.
