3. TSI Criteria for ending probation

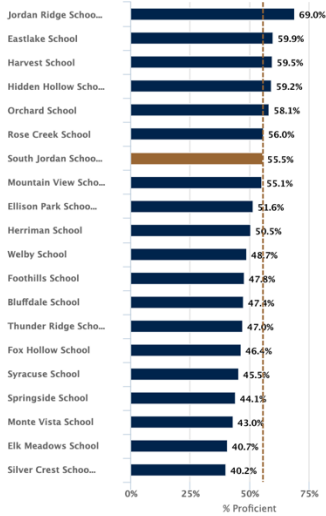

4. Growth of the lowest 25%

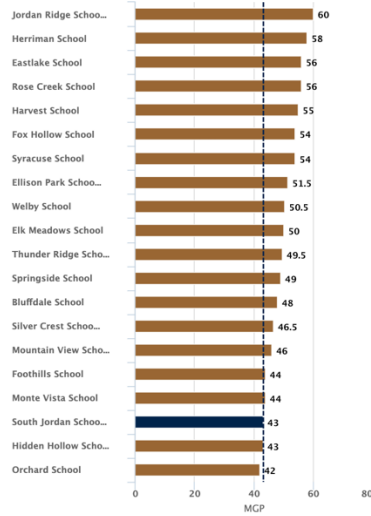
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Language Arts Mathematics Science

Language Arts % Proficient, 2018

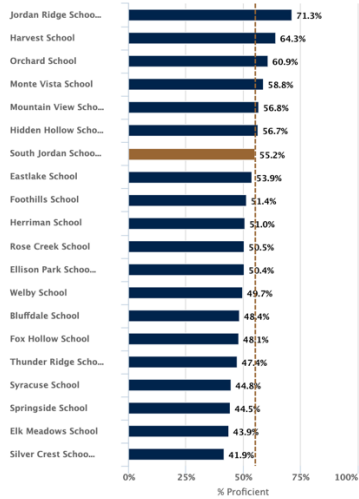


Language Arts MGP, 2018

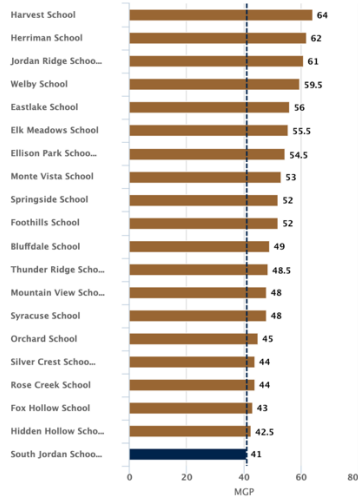


Language Arts Mathematics Science

Mathematics % Proficient, 2018

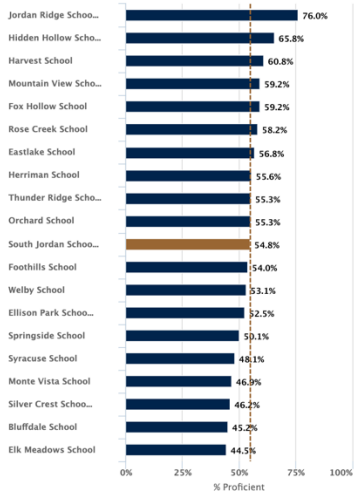


Mathematics MGP, 2018

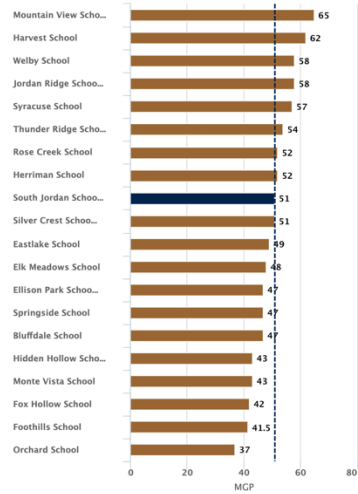


Language Arts Mathematics Science
