1. Parent Teacher Conferences

- ABC tracks conferences are the week of November 2-6.
- D track conferences are the week of November 16-20.

- Offer conferences virtually but if parents cannot or don't want virtual conferences Thursday, November 5th or 19th the building will be open until 8pm for in-person conferences.
- Teachers and parents will be able to use the Skyward scheduler for conferences.

2. Halloween options

 - 1-2 parents can come to the class
- Decided to leave it up to teachers to decide if they want parents in the classroom. Team leaders will talk more about the decision. Focus should be keeping the kids in school and safety.

Reviewed LAND Trust plan: 2 goals this year: growth in Reading and proficiency in Math

- **Math goal:** 80% of students will be proficient (70% score) in Math comparing the beginning of the year assessment and the end of year assessment. Assessment given by teachers on MasteryConnect
- Our Math coach is Sherri Peisley. 55% of LAND trust money going to pay for Sherri and 1 math assistant, and paying for teachers to attend PD.
- They are helping teachers with math especially 6th grade with new math program. Instructional ideas, activities, teaching modeling classes for all in math.
- **Reading goal:** measures growth in students learning from beginning of the year to the end of the year.
- Assessments for reading proficiency:
 - DIBELS/Acadience for reading: A 1 minute read and then re-tell what was read.
 - Grades 4-6- selected students will participate in Acadience also.
 - RI: Students read passages on a computer and then click on answers
- Every student K-3 has the Acadience test 3 times a year unless they opt out and now this year selected students in Grades 4-6 will be taking Acadience
- Our Literacy coach is also helping with diagnostic assessments with students who are struggling.
- 45% of LAND Trust pays for reading assistants in every class.
- Each teacher has filled out a typical growth calculation to determine growth for each student.
- Teachers are using Fridays for struggling student support and high performers extra activities
- Teachers and parents are loving the Fridays!

5. **TSSA/School Improvement Plan: 3 areas**

- Coaching
- Professional development
- Technology

- Majority of the money is going to coaching and technology. Waiting on order of more Chromebooks. Need more technology. We have just enough Chromebooks for students.

6. **PTA**

- PTA indicated no fundraiser this year. There is money left over from last year and cannot do same activities this year.
