Safety Procedure Suggestions Discussed

Before School:

Wear masks at all times on South Jordan Elementary property.

- All the doors are marked as going in and going out. The school is NOT permitting students to play on the playground before or after school. The school will be unlocked at 8:15, 10 minutes before school starts. The doors will be opened for the students by a teaching assistant.
- Suggestion: That we encourage students with last names from A-K to drop off at 8:10 a.m. and then L-Z at 8:20 a.m. Then, switch mid-year.

During School:

- Wear masks at all times on South Jordan Elementary property.
- The class will take breaks throughout the day.
- After each grade level recess, the playground will be cleaned.
- The specialists will travel to the classrooms to provide instruction.
- Students wash hands EVERY TIME they leave the classroom.
- Students cannot share hand sanitizer or supplies brought from home.
- There are 2 places for quarantine.
- The restrooms are being frequently cleaned.
- Students will be placed in alphabetical order when they travel to different locations, like lunch or library.

Lunch:

- Lunch times are further apart. Only one grade will eat at a time.
- Lunch tables will be spread out.
- Only 6 children per table and spaced apart. Seats will be assigned.
- Home lunches: We are encouraging home lunches that are in disposable sacks.
- Lunch time will be from 11:10-1:10.

After School:

- Wear masks at all times on South Jordan Elementary property.
- Morning Kindergarten: Students will be released by walkie-talkie from the classrooms. Put your student's name in the windshield and they will be called on the walkie to come to your car individually.

Teachers:

- Teachers are working hard on redesigning lessons to have a safe, productive learning environment
- Just over 200 SJE students chose to be online learners. South Jordan teachers will mainly teach South Jordan Elementary students.

Fridays

Teachers will be bringing in students who need additional supports one-on-one or in small groups.
 Buses are running on Fridays and students will be at school from 10:30 – 1:25. Lunch will be provided.
