- 1. Welcome and review minutes from the January meeting January Review- Trust Lands Plan 25-26- \$132,673
 - Critical areas of need
 - Current school year goals:
 - 1. 75% will show typical or above growth as measured by End of Year Acadience scores.
 - 2. 61% math growth percentile as measured by the RISE assessment
- **New curriculum in both math and reading may impact scores as teachers are new and learning the curriculum this year and next year.
 - Possible Goals:
 - 1. Keep reading goal the same as current year
 - 2. Math goal 60% growth percentile as measured by RISE with new curriculum changes
 - Possible expenditures
 - 1. Literacy aides (largest portion)
 - 2. Chromebooks
 - 3. Instructional coach
 - 4. Not allowed more than 10% carry-over (currently leave no carry-over)
 - 5. Data notebooks
 - 6. More Wits and Wisdom books and supplemental resources
 - 7. Extension resources for accelerated learners
 - 8. Math aide for upper grades
 - Expected expenditures

2. Patron Comments (if any)

Good experience for most with new dropoff procedures. PTA is happy to do a review every few months. Complaints mostly that it is inconvenient. Cones are better in the morning than the afternoon. Kindergarten pickup changes the flow in the afternoon. One parent suggested an additional crosswalk on the south end into the neighborhood east of the school.

3. 2024-2025 Trustlands Plan

- a. Discuss Acadience results BOY school average 78% proficient and MOY school average 76% proficient. Tests and targets are different each time. It is common for a drop in MOY and then a rise for EOY. School average had 66% growth from BOY to MOY.
- b. Finalize 2024-2025 Trustlands Plan
- I. 75% will show typical or above growth as measured by End of Year Acadience scores. Funds for literacy aides, instructional coach salary, Wits and Wisdom books, and Chromebooks.
- II. 55% math growth percentile as measured by the RISE assessment. Funds for professional development for new math curriculum and possible math aide if extra funds.

4. White Ribbon Week update

- a. Let's Get Real program ordered for the first week of March. Focus on healthy habits and face-to-face relationships.
- b. Power Up magazine for parents ordered and will go home to parents to help parents talk to children about getting off devices.
